CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Each club, member of FIAP or not, can send their works to gilrossellduchamps@gmail.com **using WeTransfer**. 20 digital photos Black and White and/or color. Works accepted in previous World Cups cannot participate. Coherency between photos is not required. Sending photos by CDs is not recommended. However, if you wish to do so, please use this address: **Gil Rossell, Avinguda de Rouillac 14, AD200, Encamp, Andorra**

RULES FOR AUTHORS

Operational Members cannot participate.

PLEASE NOTE: 20 PHOTOS ARE MANDATORY.

Each author can only participate in one club with a maximum of 2 works.

International teams are forbidden. However, one foreign author is allowed.

WORKS SIZE

Files should be **RGB, JPG 10 compressed, 300dpi, 2400 pixels minimum for the larger side** in order to be printed for the exhibition.

Files should be named **01_club-name 02_club-name up to 20_club-name**.

The Excel entry-form (00_club-name.xls) must also be sent with the works.

ENTRY FEE

There is no fee for ILFIAP Clubs, which already pay a member fee to FIAP.

The entry fee is **50€** (not \$) per club for non ILFIAP member clubs, to be paid:

PRIZES

The FIAP Club's World Cup is awarded as follows:

2017 Club's World Cup for the best club.

FIAP Gold medal for the club ranked second.

FIAP Silver medal for the club ranked third.

FIAP Bronze medal for the club ranked fourth.

Six honourable mentions for the clubs ranked 5th to 10th.

The authors of the club ranked first receive an honourable mention.

One FIAP gold medal, two FIAP silver medals and three FIAP bronze medals will award works of exceptional quality, independently of the club's classification.

Judges could award up to 5 individual mentions, as portrait, landscape, creativity, or all kind of themes they will decide.

Each judge will also choose his personal favourite.

Each author can only receive one prize.

The Club having achieved the best results from 2011 to 2017, will receive the **Maurice Dorikens Trophy 2011-2017**

CATALOGUE-EXHIBITION

Each participating club will receive a catalogue on CD-Rom. All accepted works will be reproduced in the catalogue.

Prize-winning works as well as one work per author from the winning Club of the World Cup, as well as from the

clubs classified up to ten, will be exhibited during the award ceremony. Place of award ceremony will be communicated later.
